The splendid setting of the new LeBreton Flats Park in Canada's Capital is the breath-taking backdrop for this unique outdoor opera concert event.






FRAME BY FRAME: The Invisible Art of Carol Spier 1 x 52 MIN.


IN SEARCH OF A SOUL: Building the Canadian War Museum 1 x 48 MIN.

JEWEL ON THE HILL: The History of Canada's Parliament Buildings 2 x 48 MIN.



MORE THAN MEETS THE EYE: Behind the Scenes at the National Gallery of Canada 1 x 27 MIN.



Museum curators, gallerists, art experts and eight incredibly talented artists share their secrets of making it into the centric circles of the Canadian art world.




TOLLER CRANSTON: The Art of Being 1 x 48 MIN.
